Who completed the survey?

A survey was sent to every household in the parish:

590 households completed the survey



11% of all households in the parish (based on 5,593 households, 2011 Census)

Bricket Wood: 34% of responses

Chiswell Green: 20% of responses

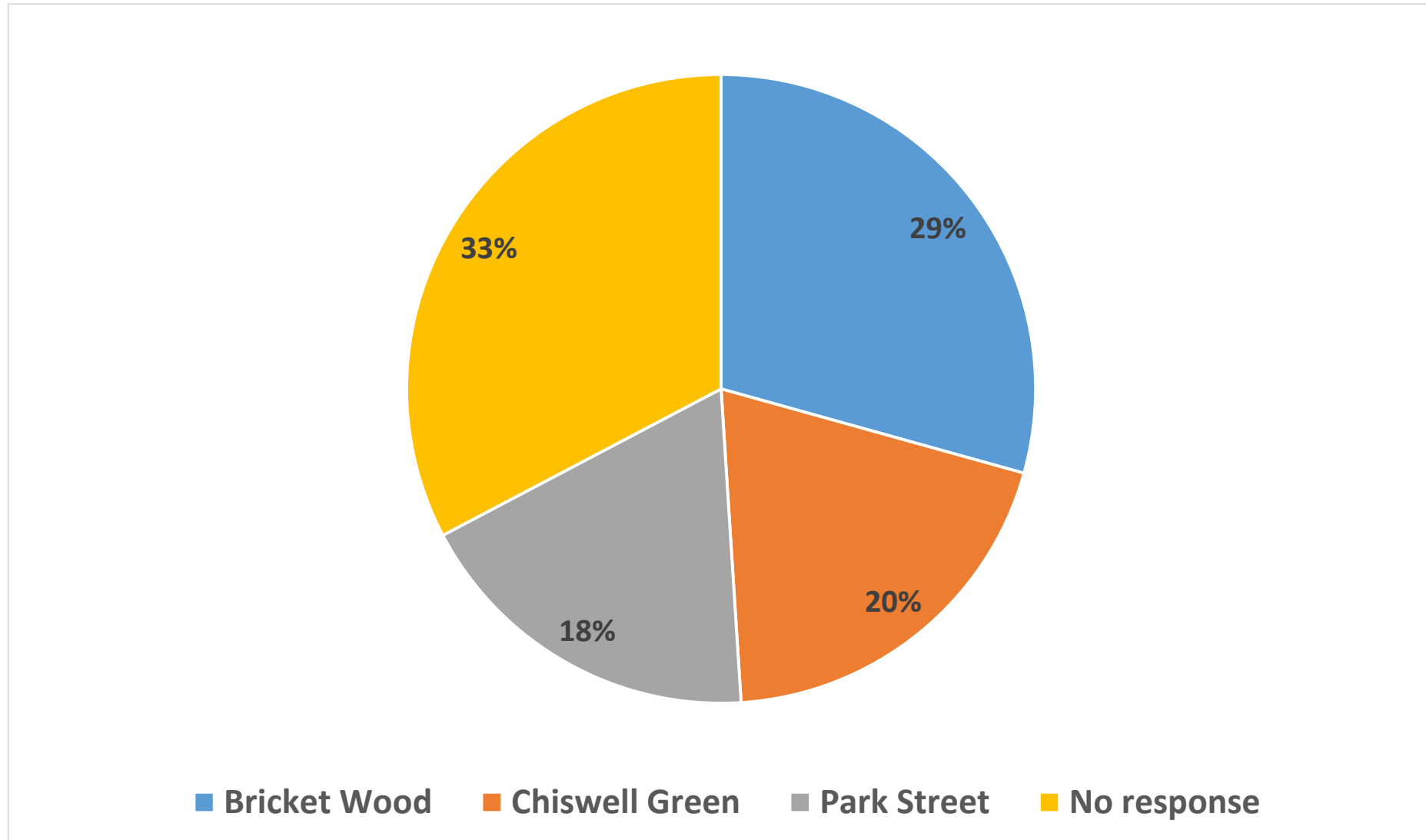
Park Street: 18% of responses

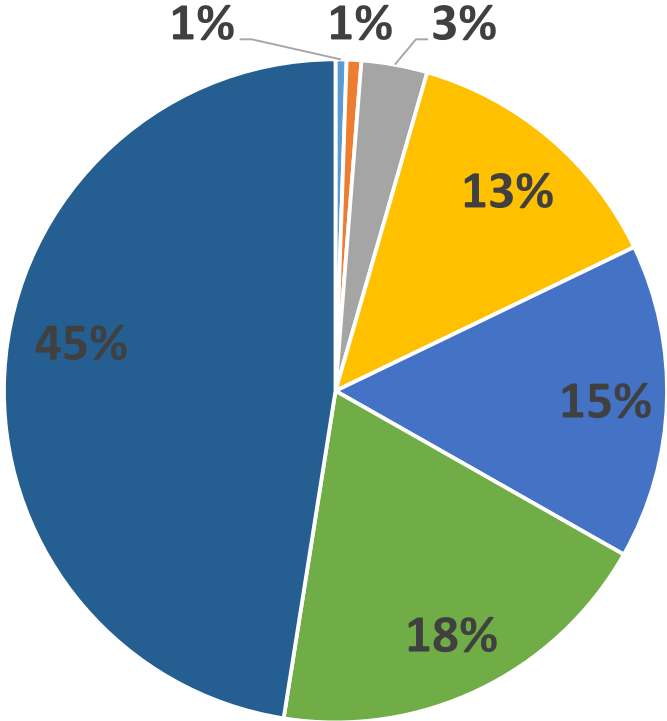

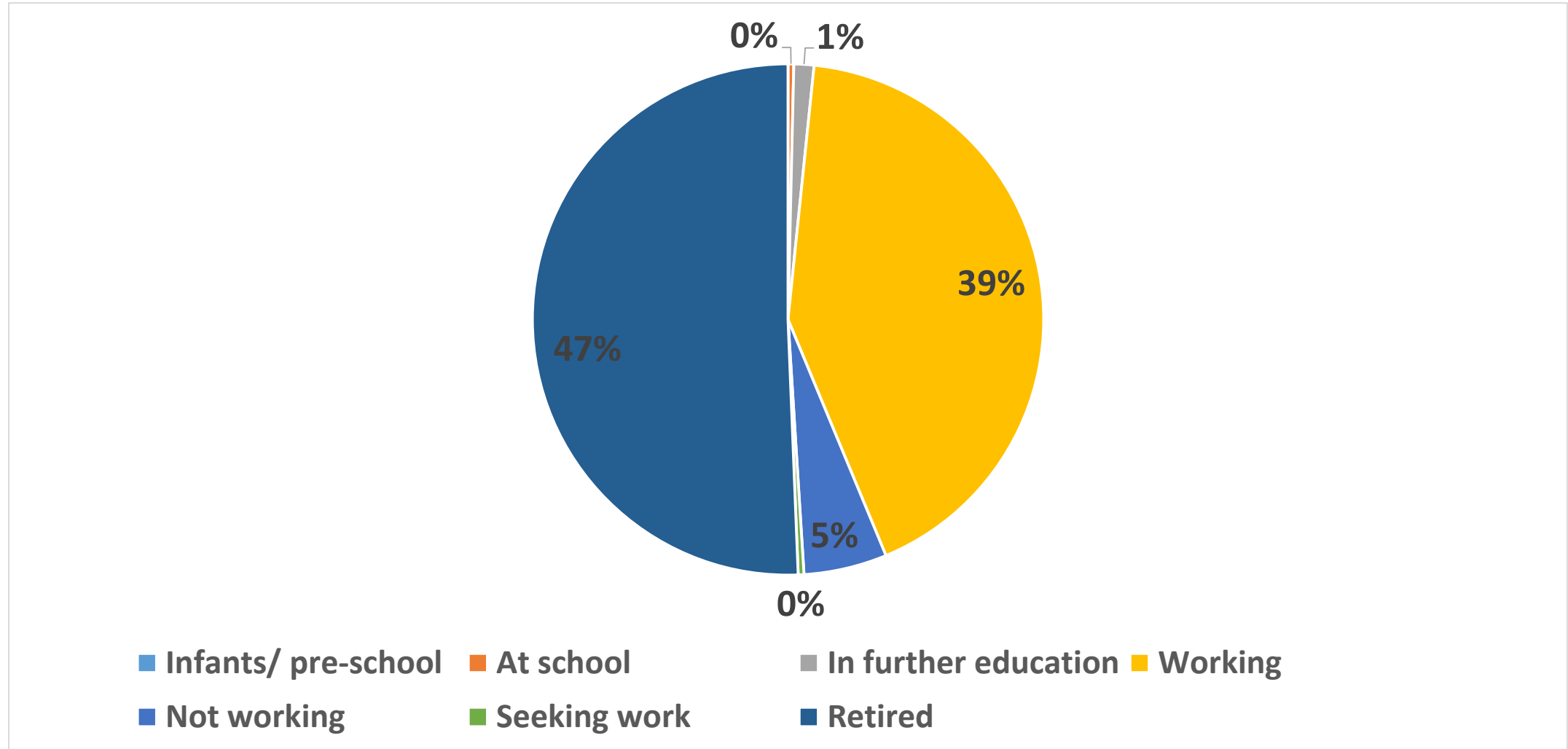

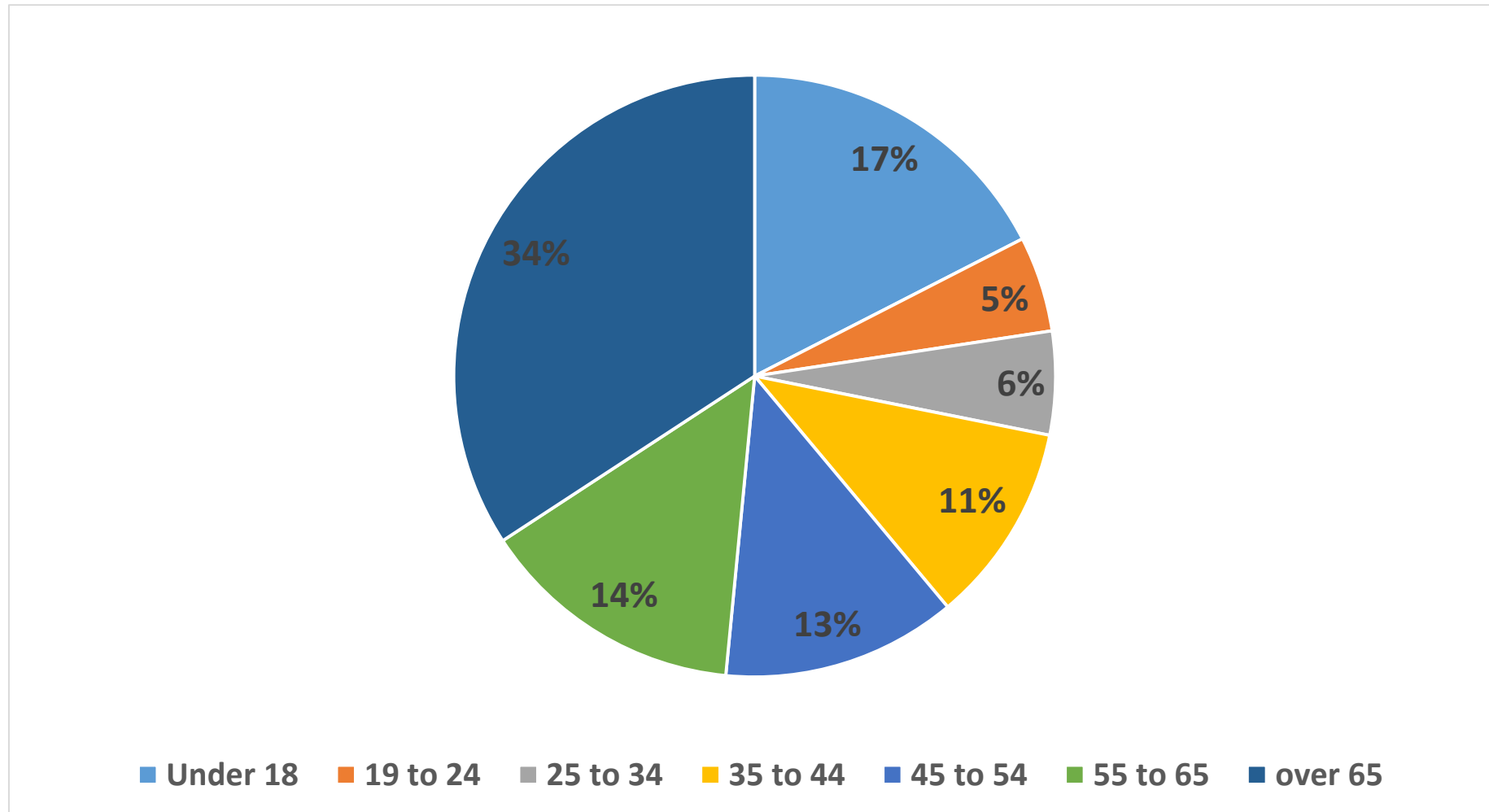

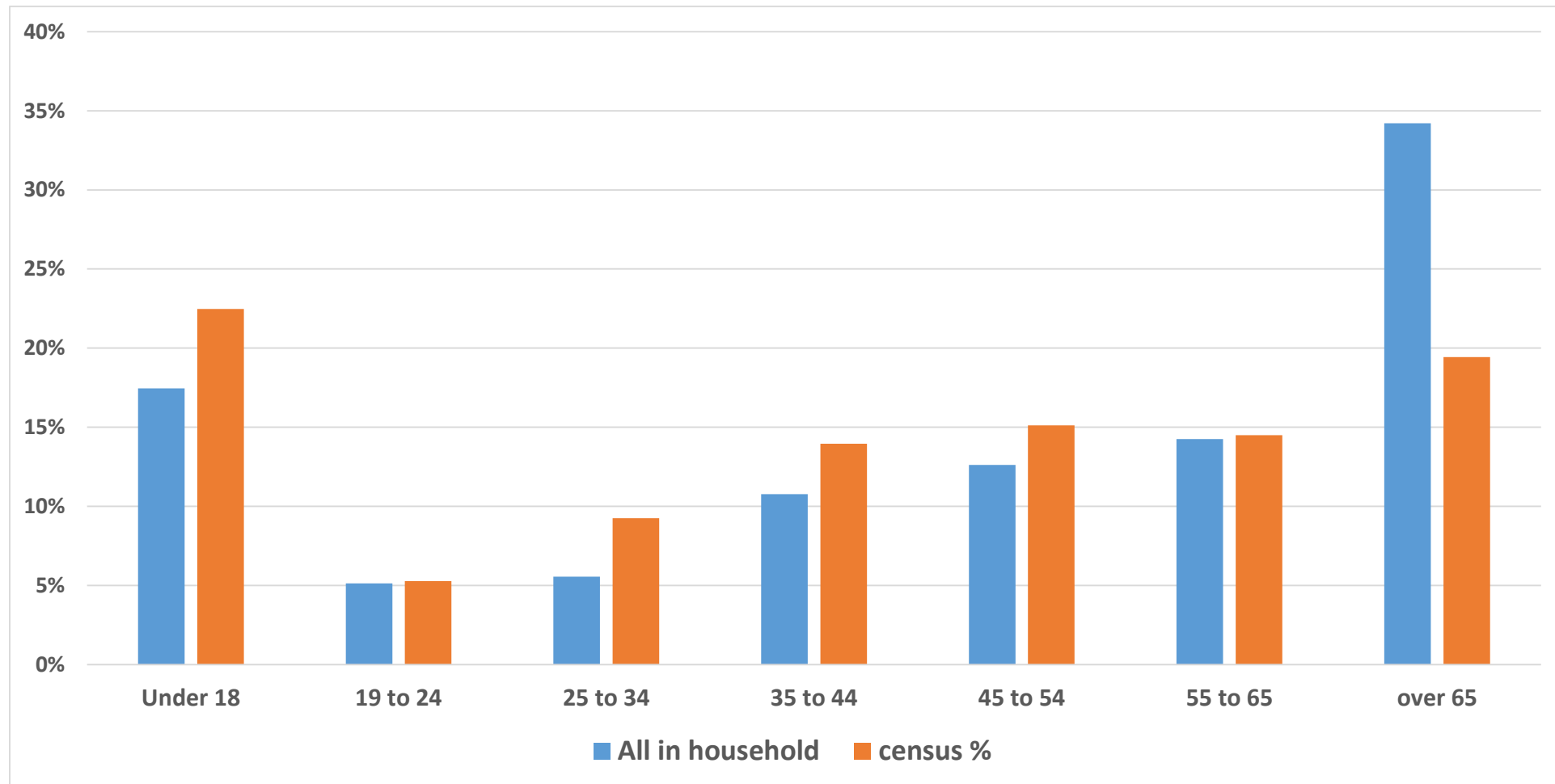
Which best describes your situation?



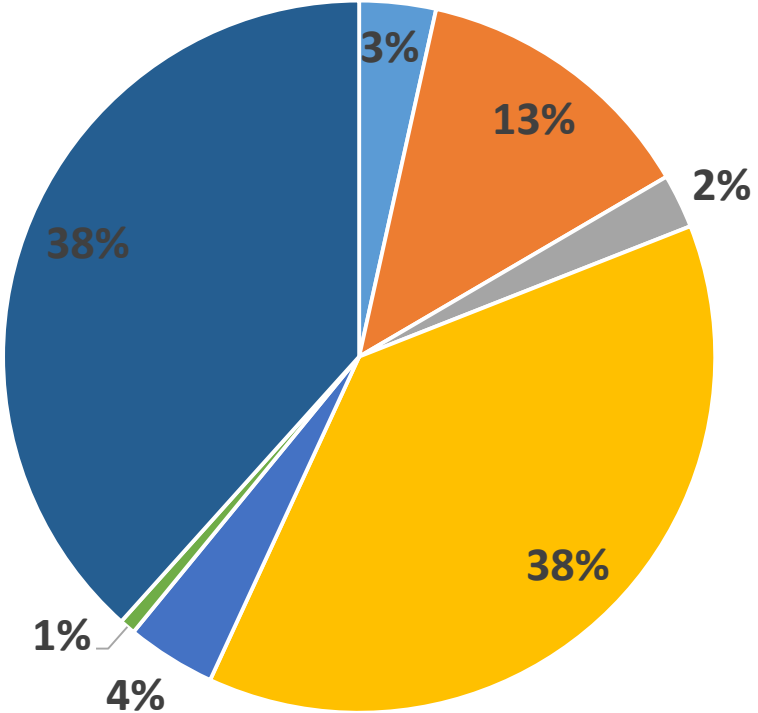
Ages of ALL represented in the household (inc you)

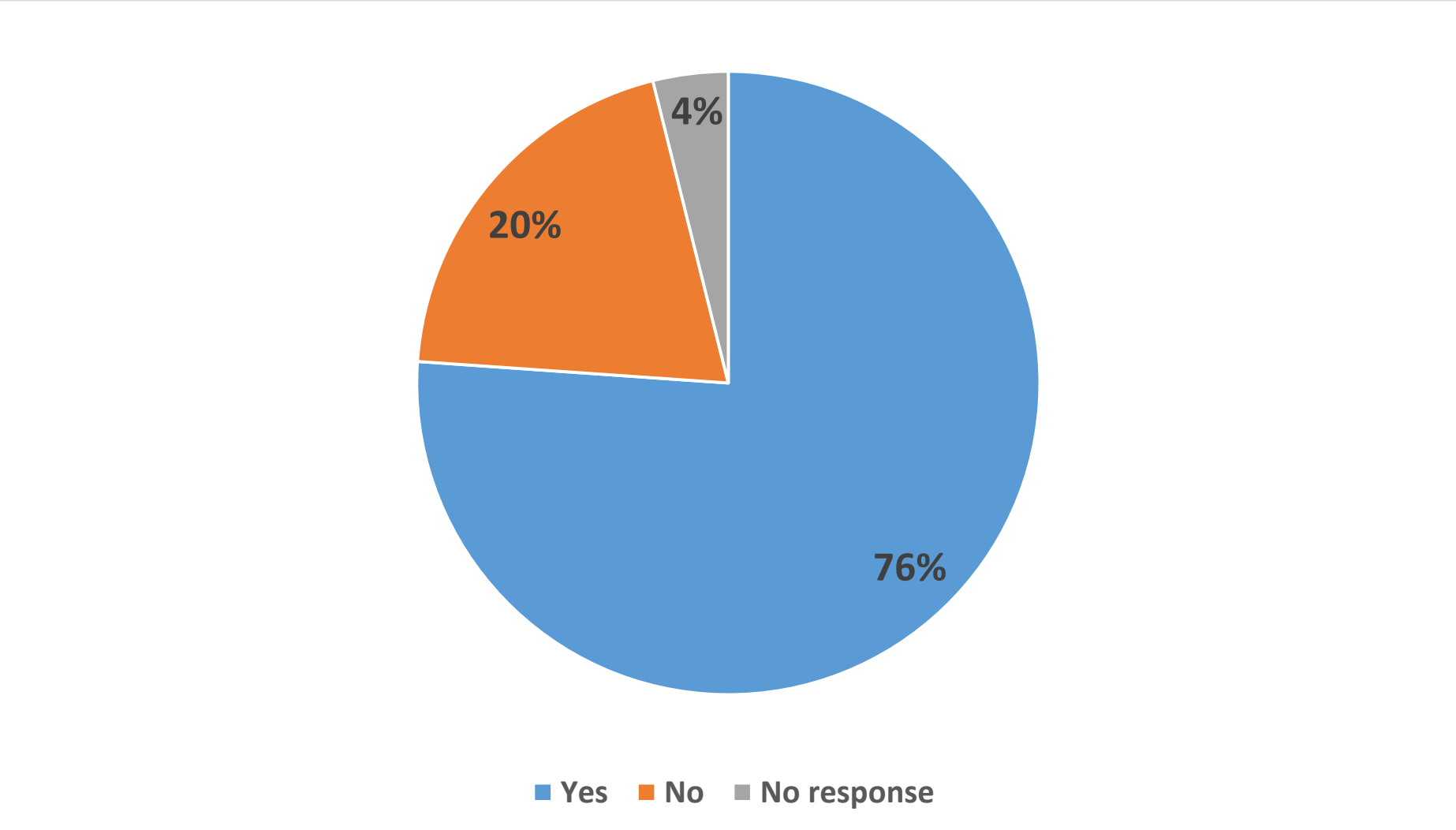

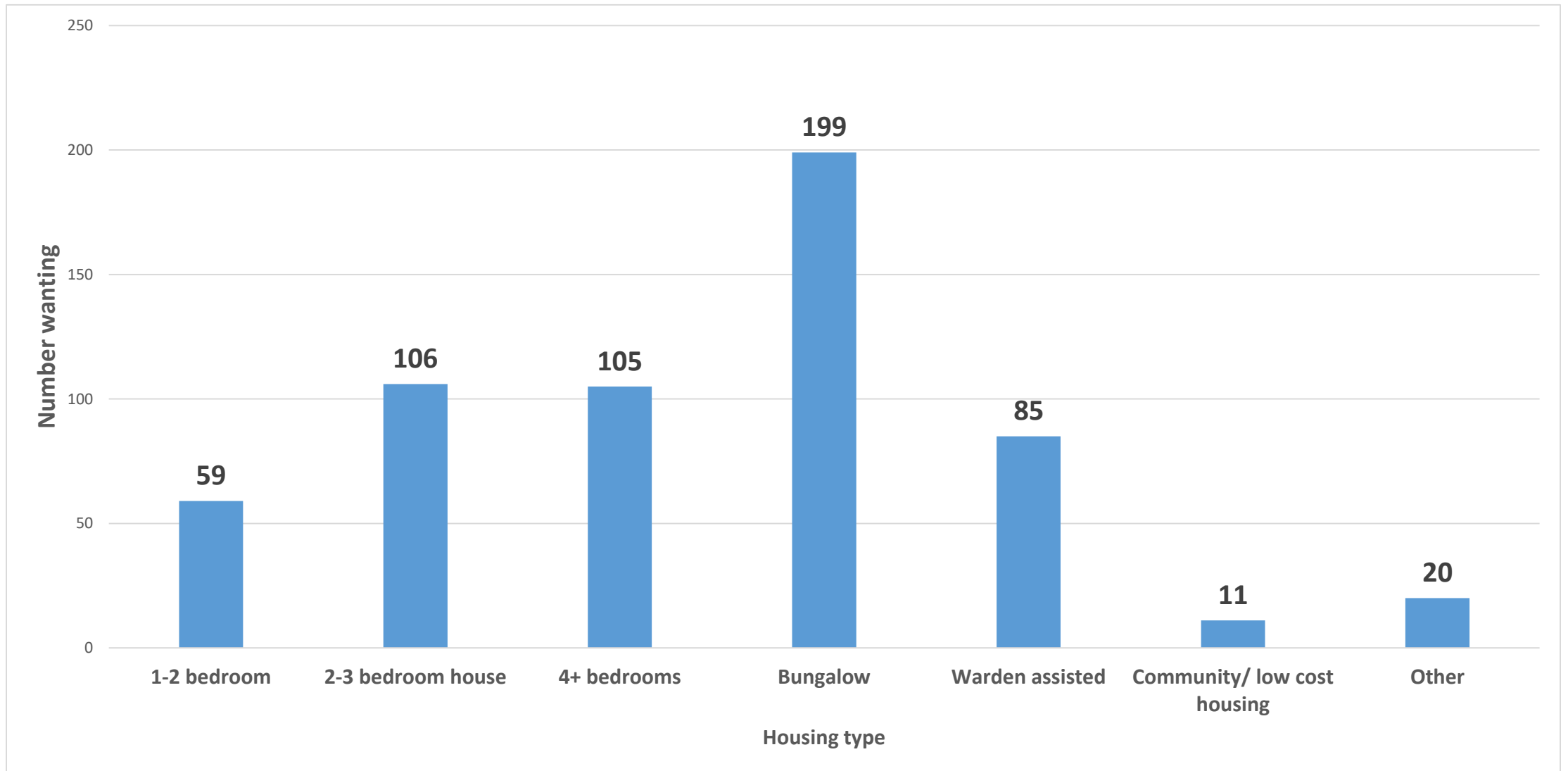

Housing

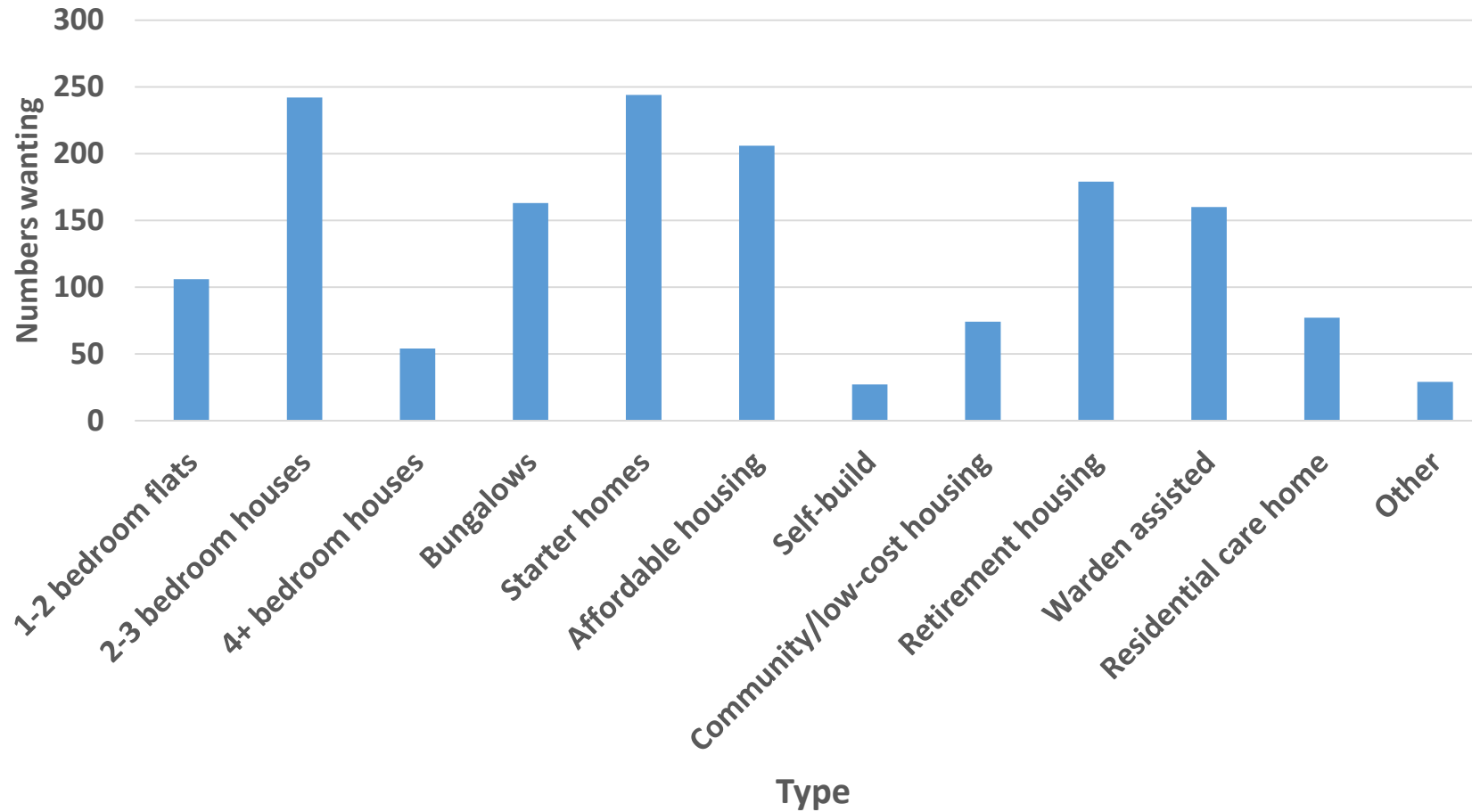
If, in the future, you decide to move house would you ideally choose to remain within the area?



If you answered 'Yes', what type of housing do you seek?



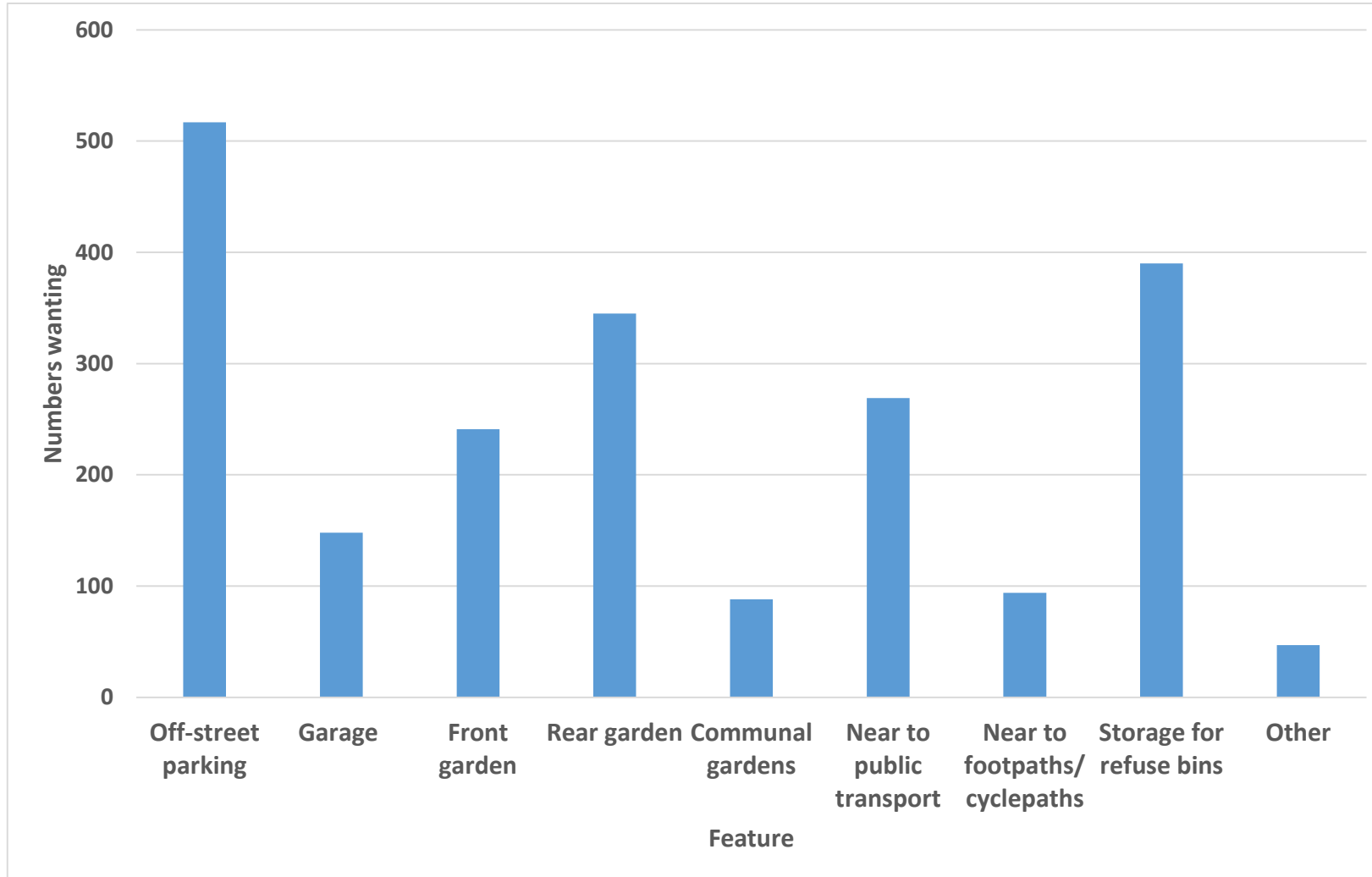
Thinking about the needs of other people (perhaps family members or older residents) what type of properties do you consider the area needs in the future?

- Homes for local people

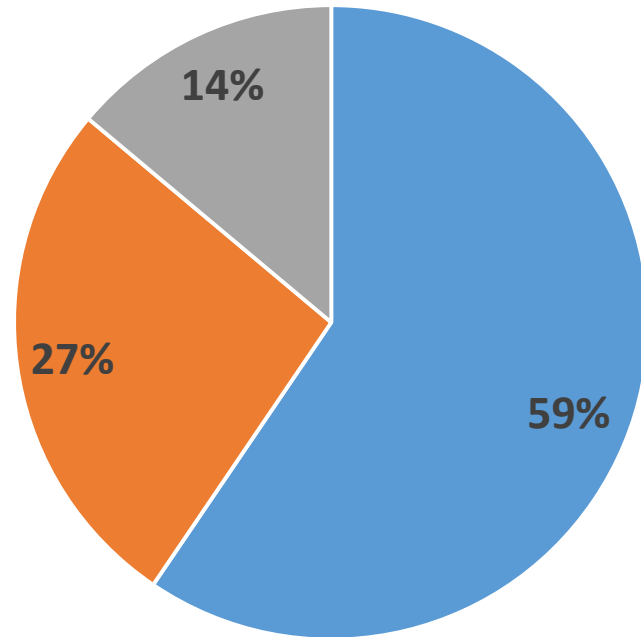
If more housing were to be built in the area, what features/facilities should be incorporated?

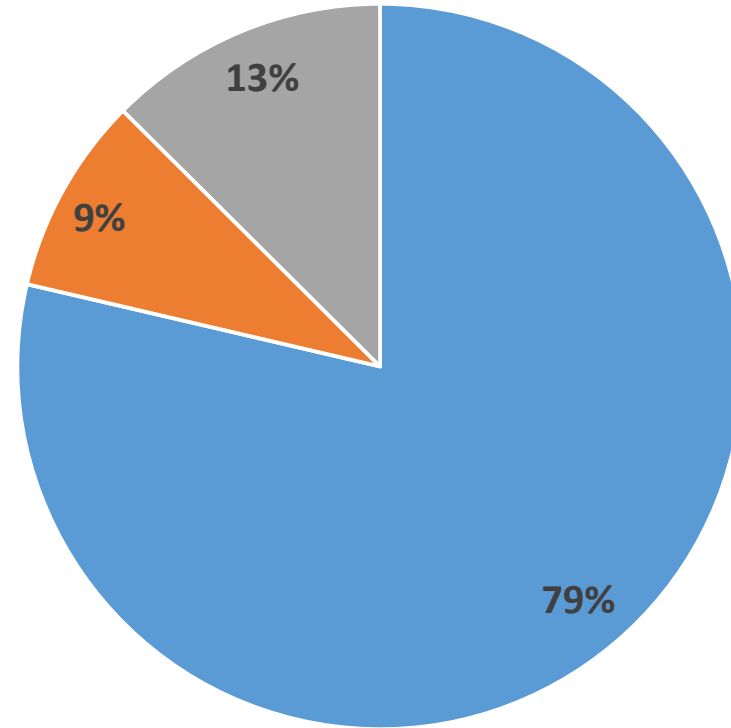

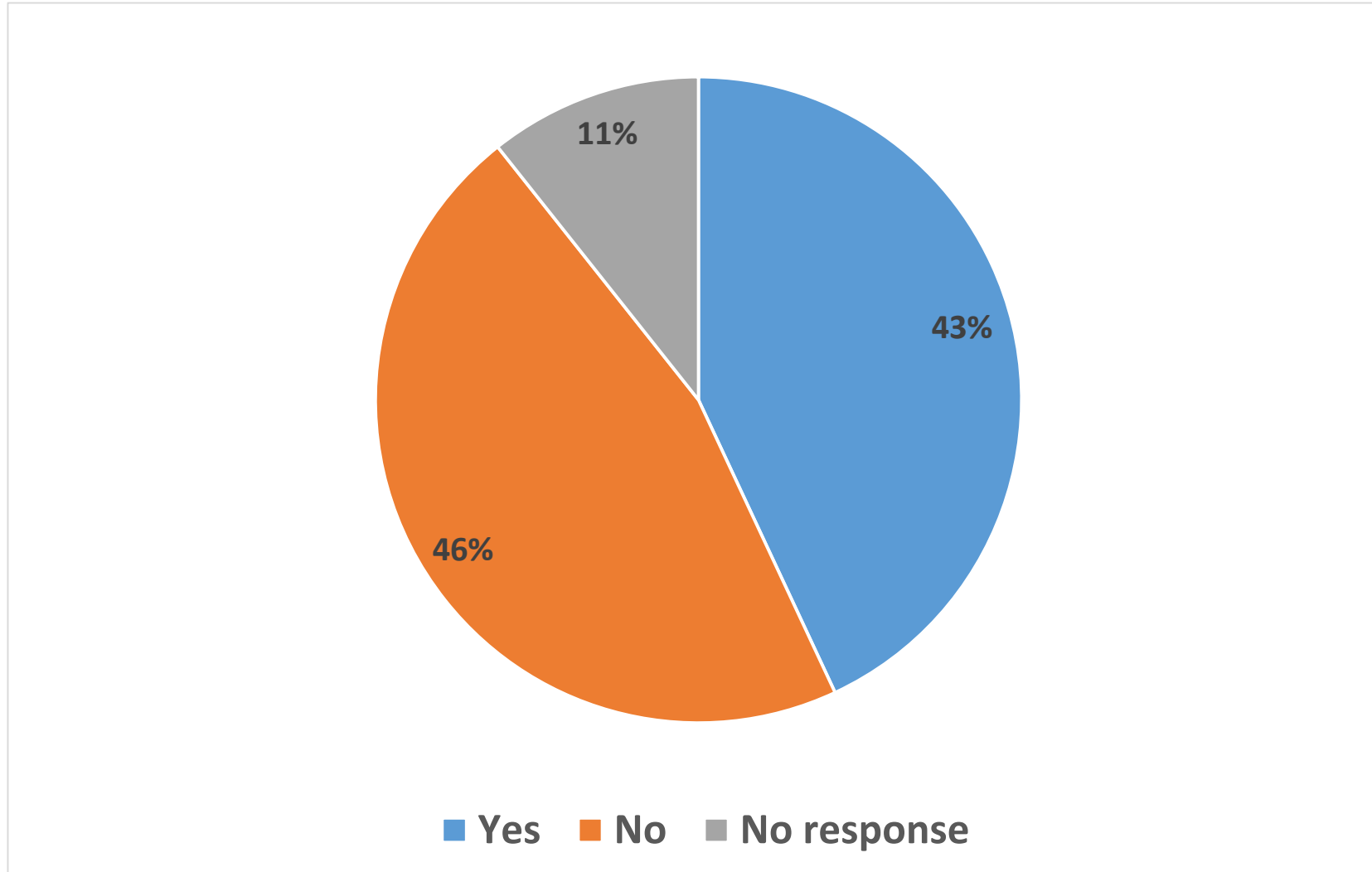
Do you support the introduction of 'green energy' solutions on new and existing properties... provided **solar panels** are in keeping with and blend into the style of housing?

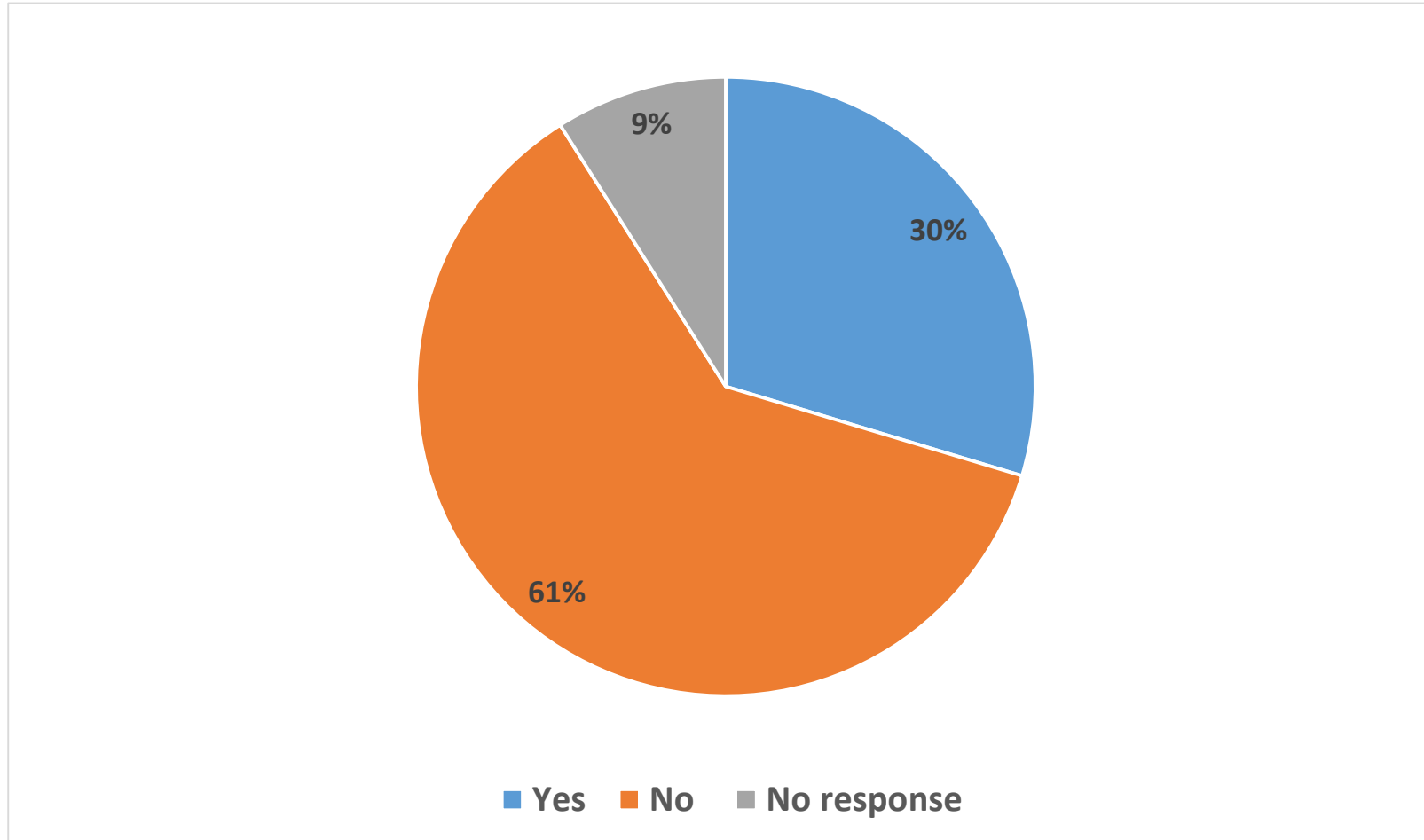

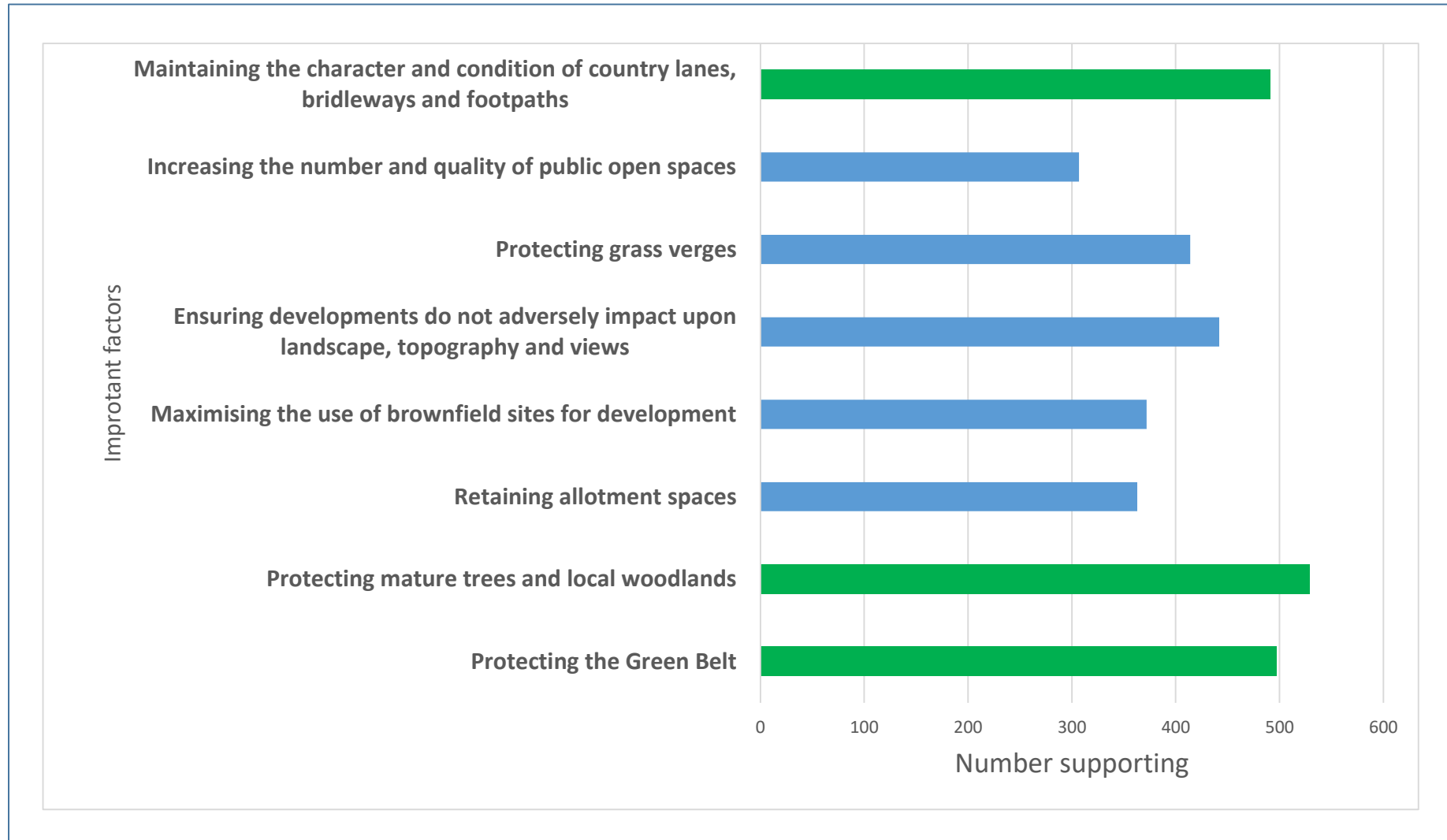

Which of the following do you think important in enhancing the nature of the area?

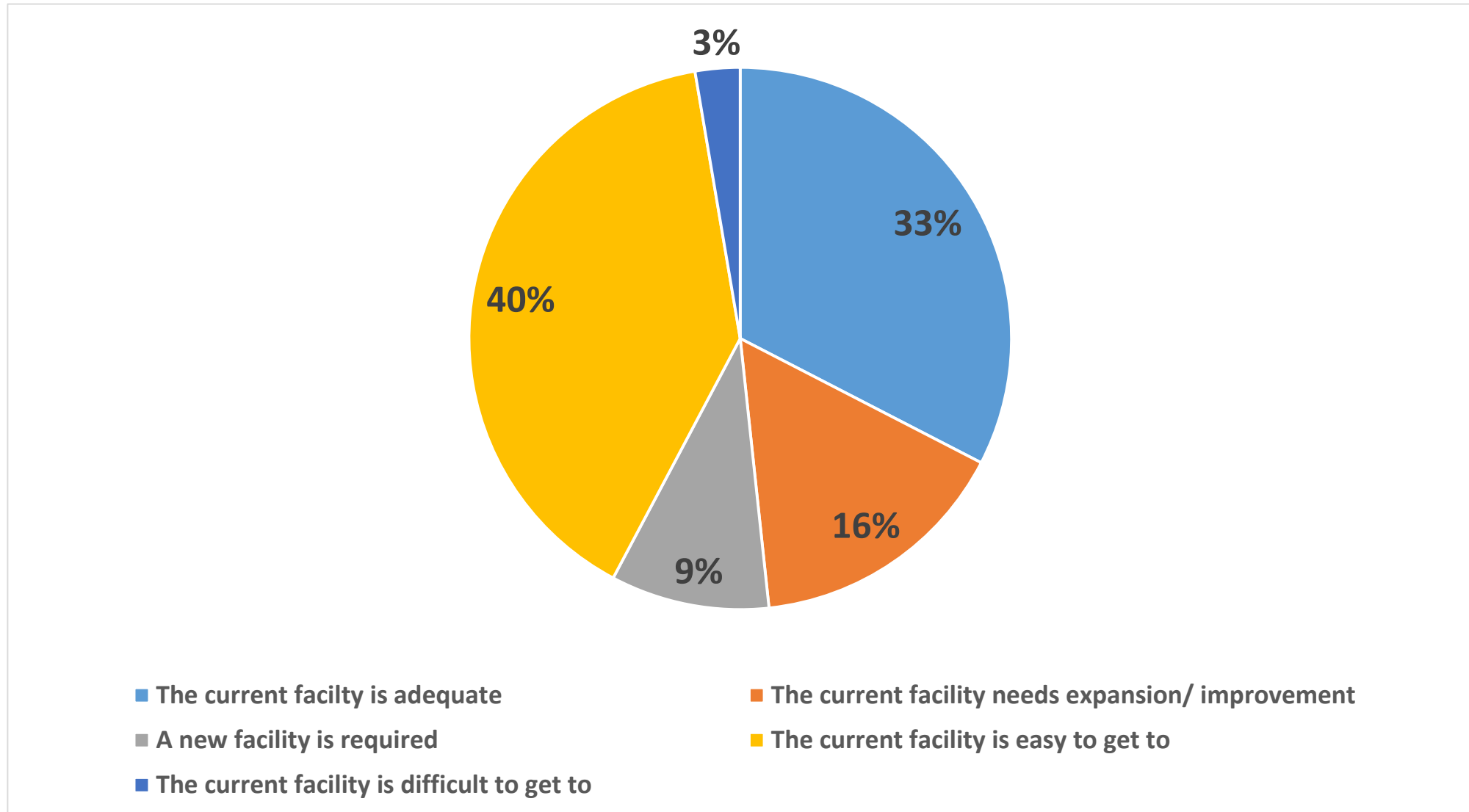




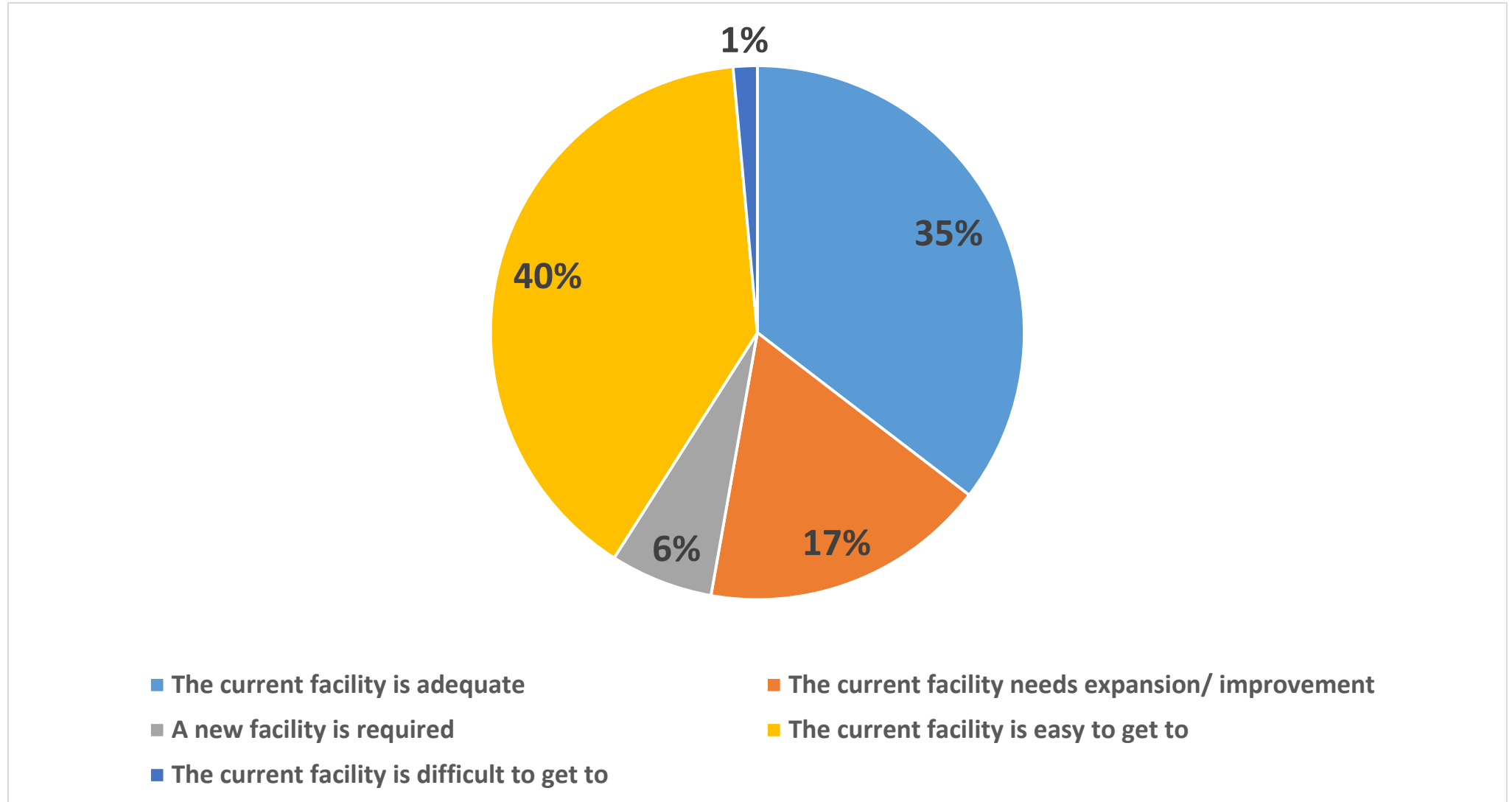

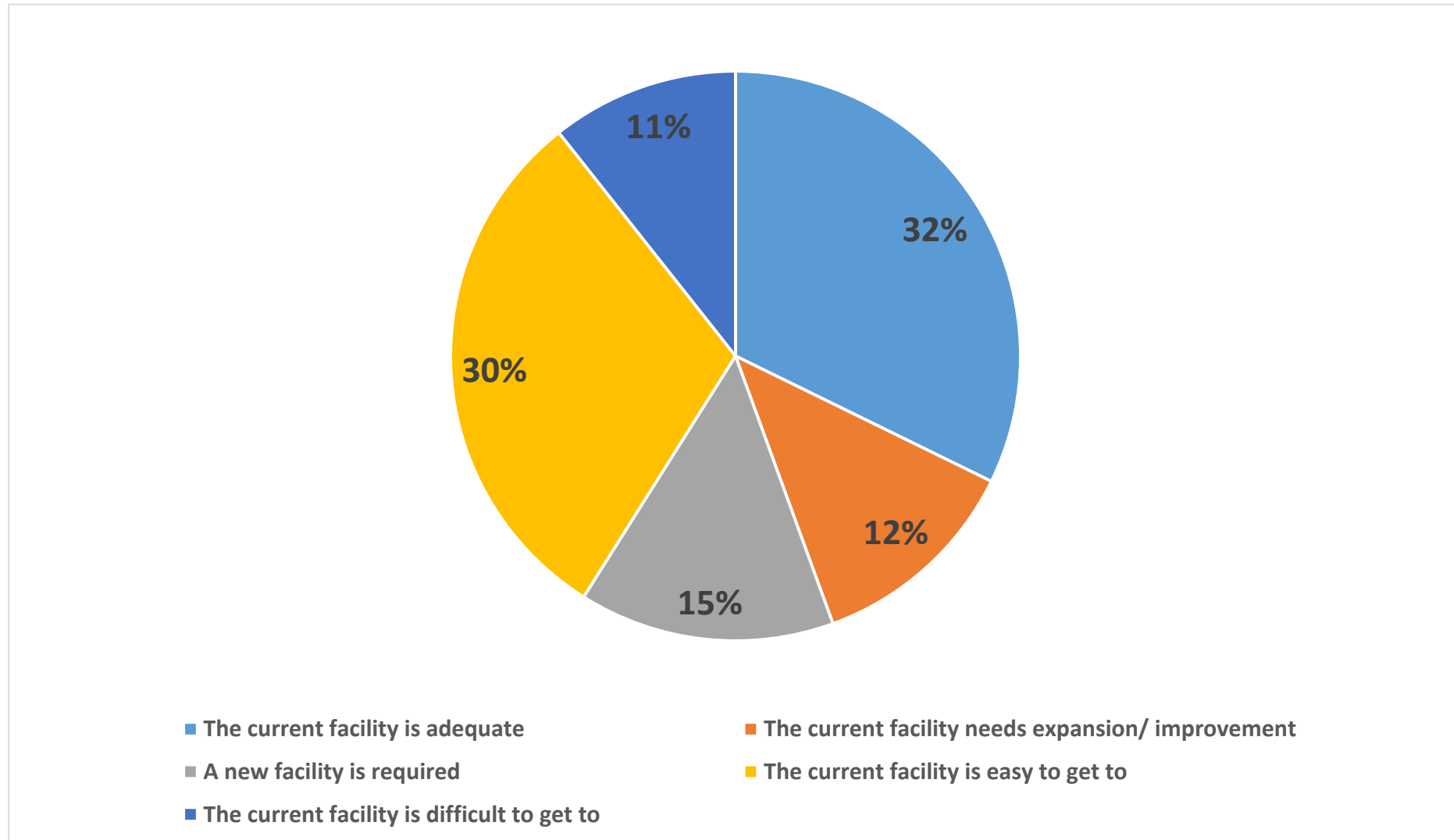

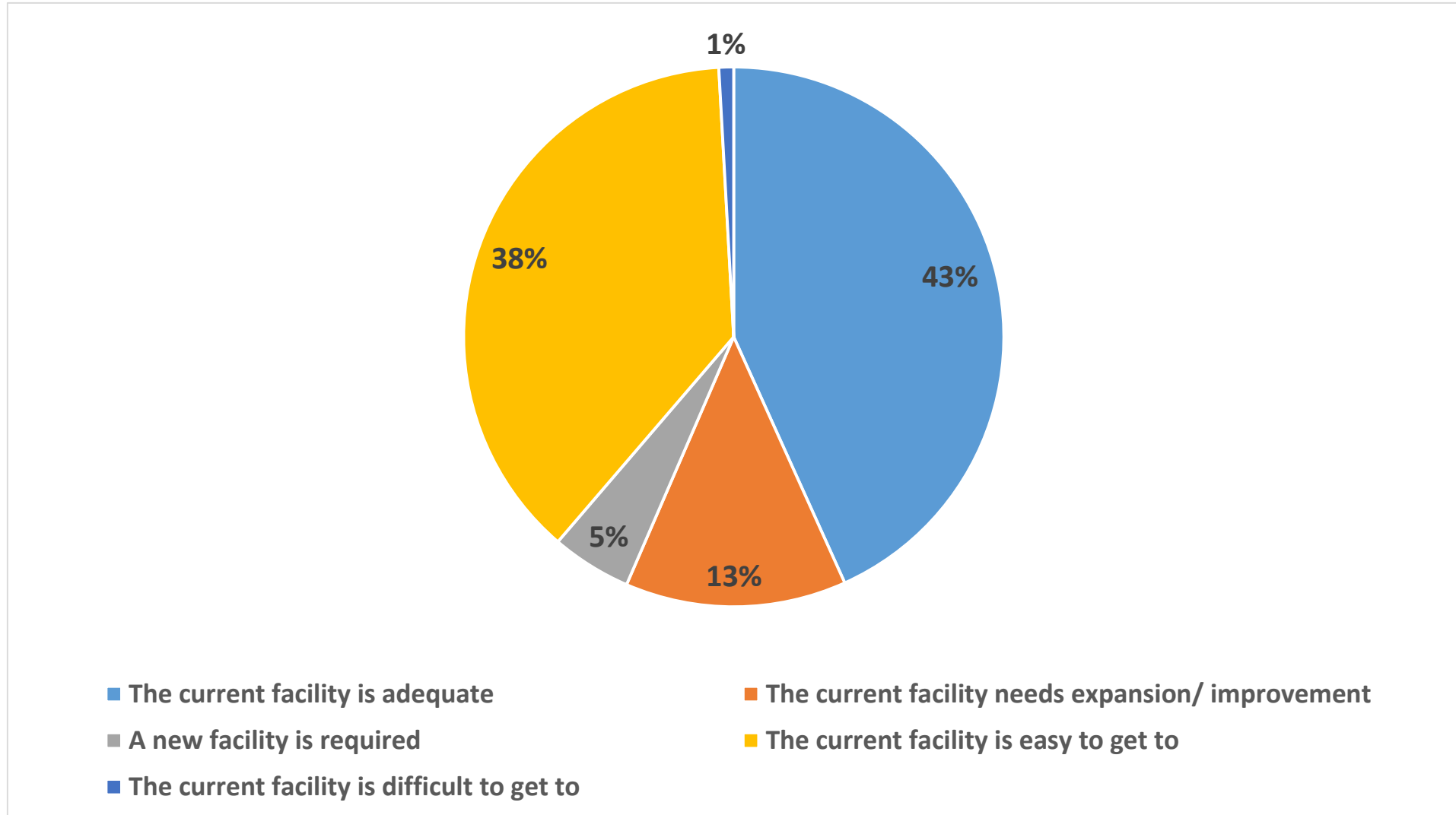
What are your views on the following services and facilities? Primary Schools



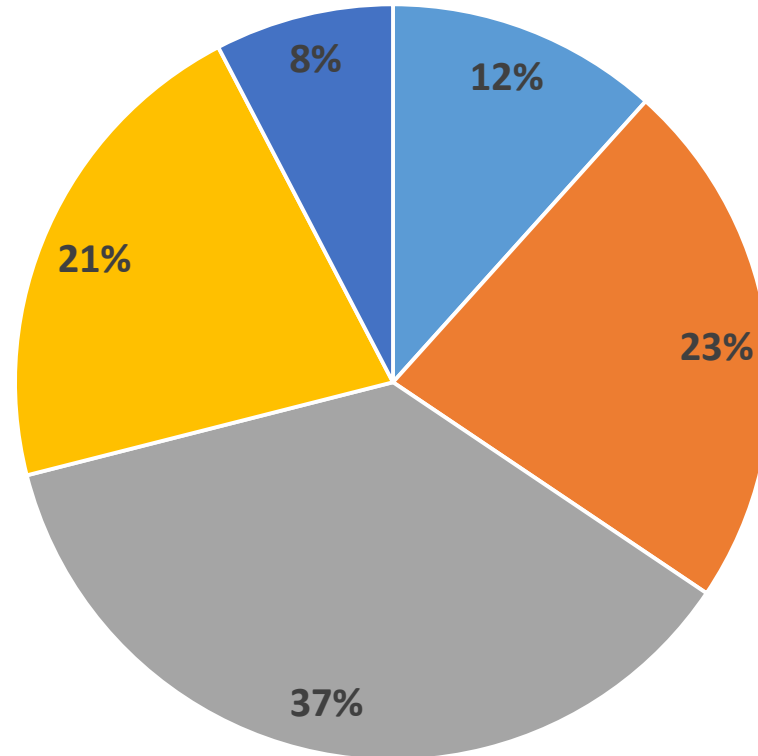
What are your views on the following services and facilities? Secondary Schools

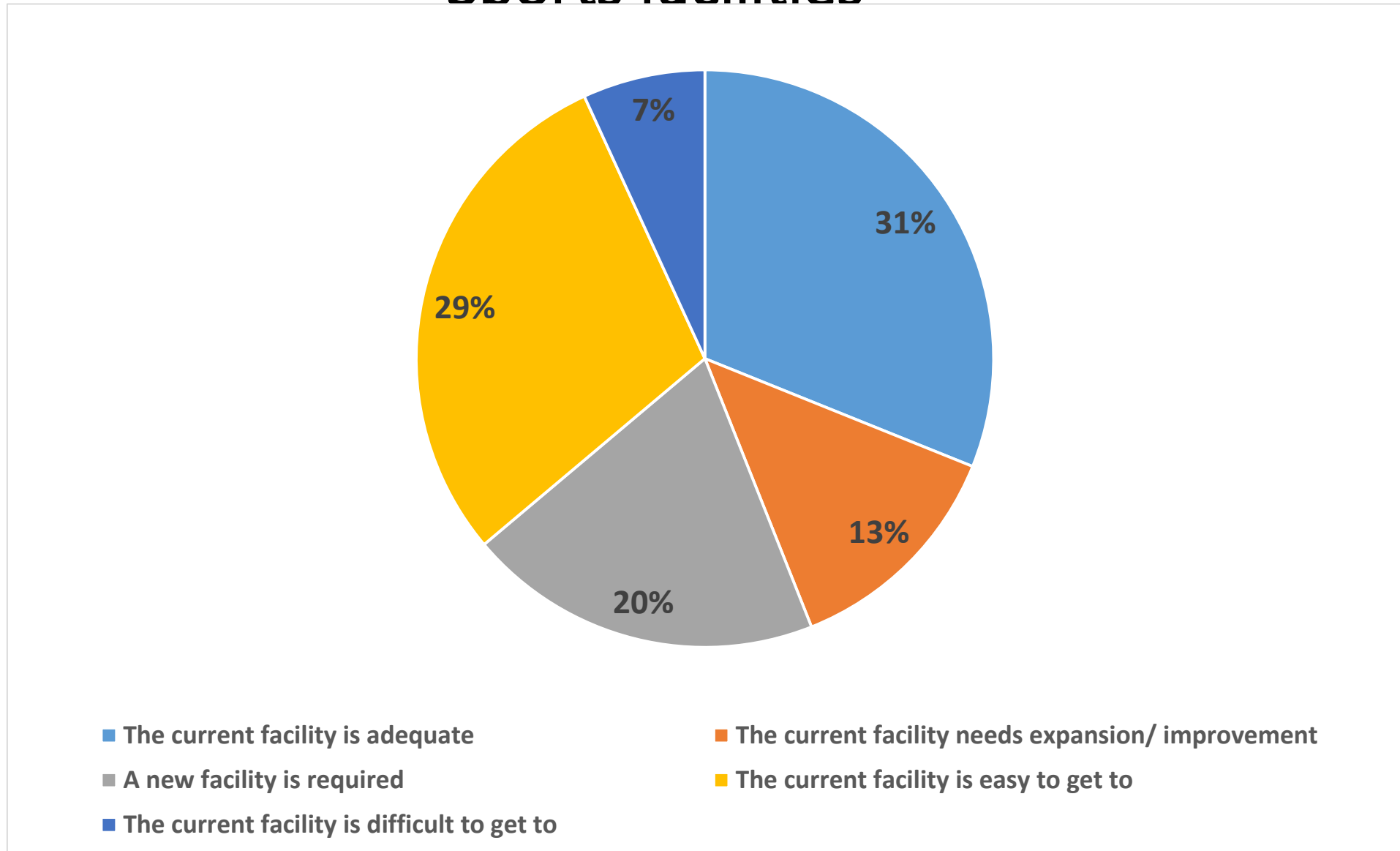

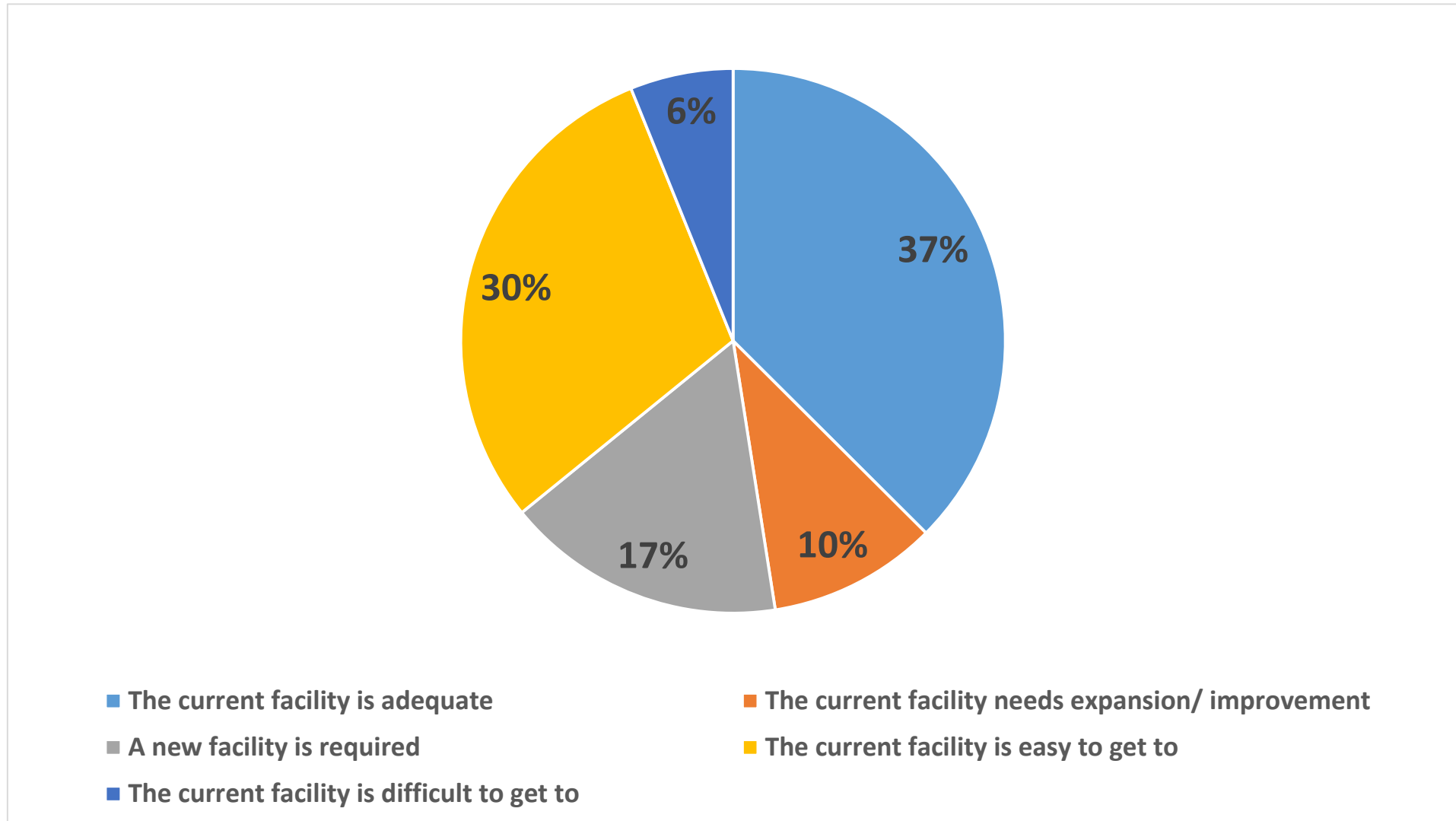

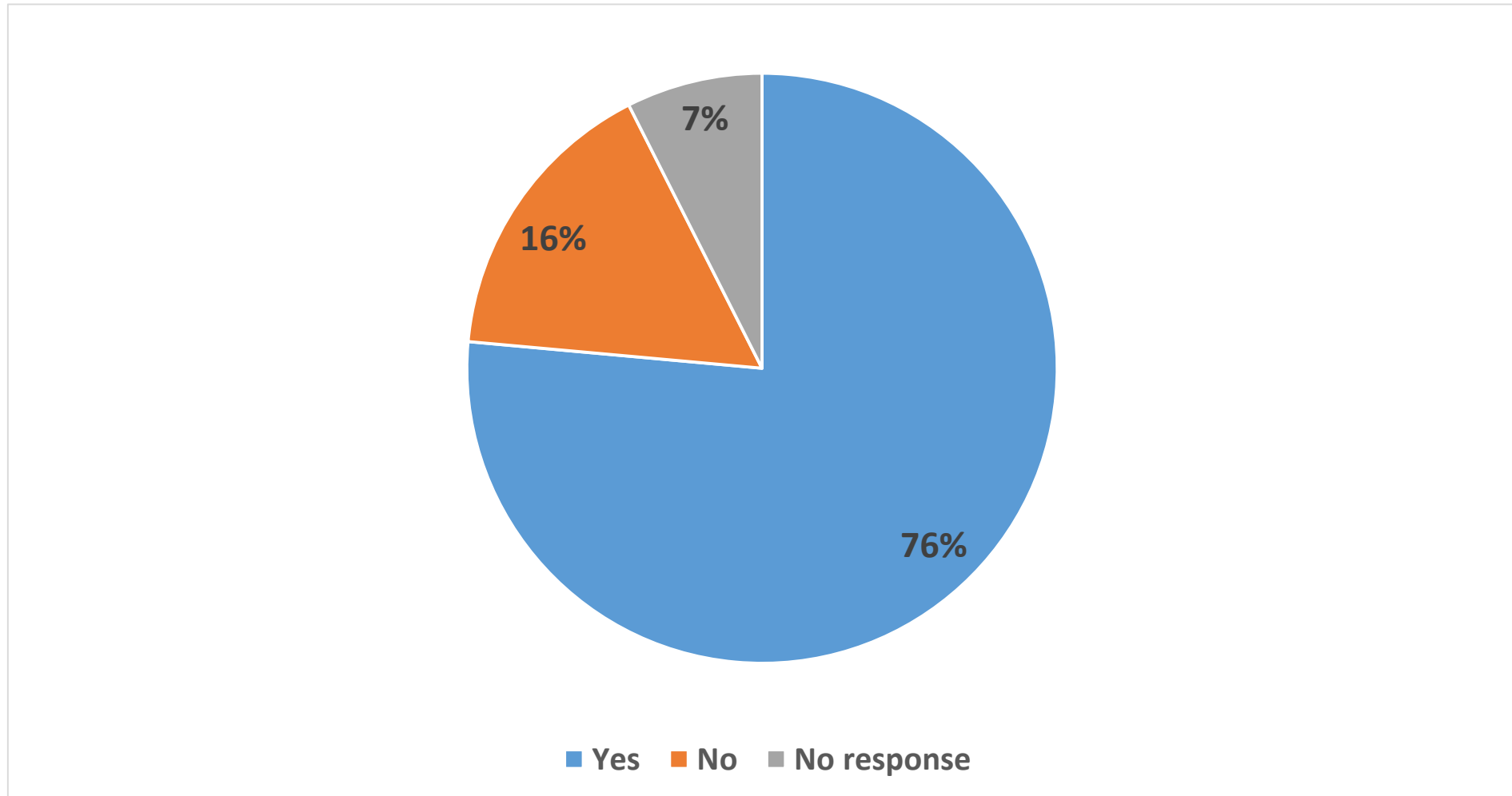
Which improvements would encourage you to use public transport (bus and / or train) more frequently?



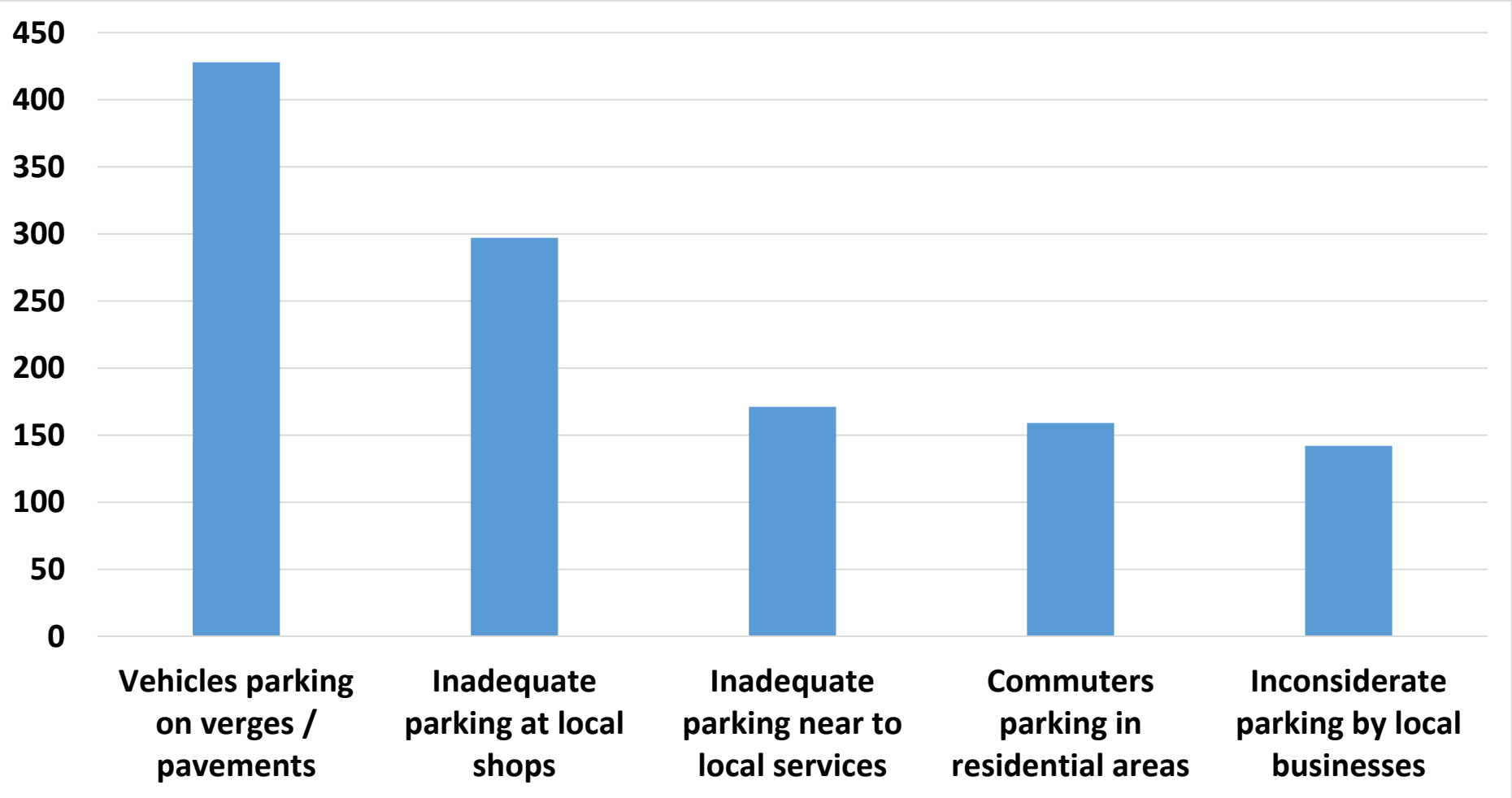
If improvements were made which type of journeys would you be more likely to use public transport for?



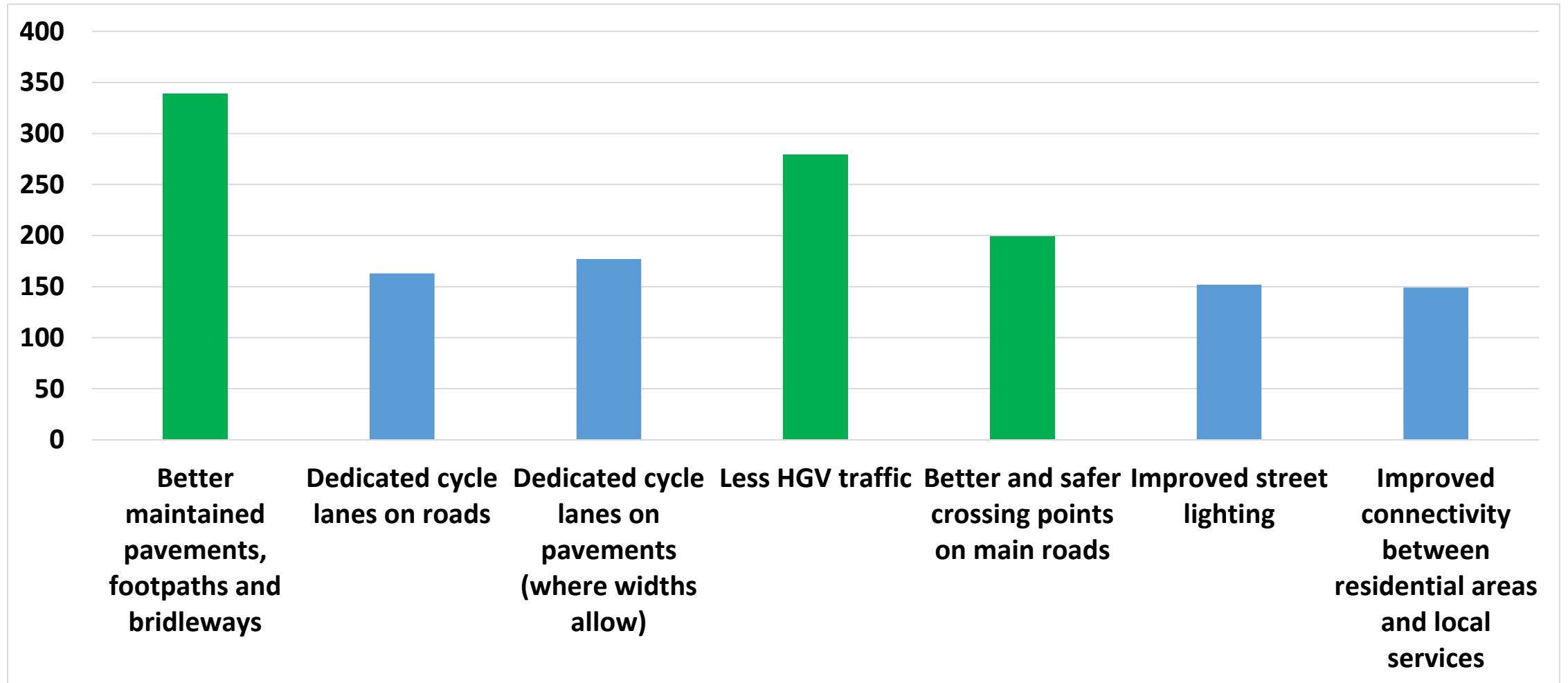
Would you support the introduction of traffic calming measures, such as flashing speed signs or reduced speed limits on certain roads?

Which of the following improvements would encourage you to walk or cycle more?

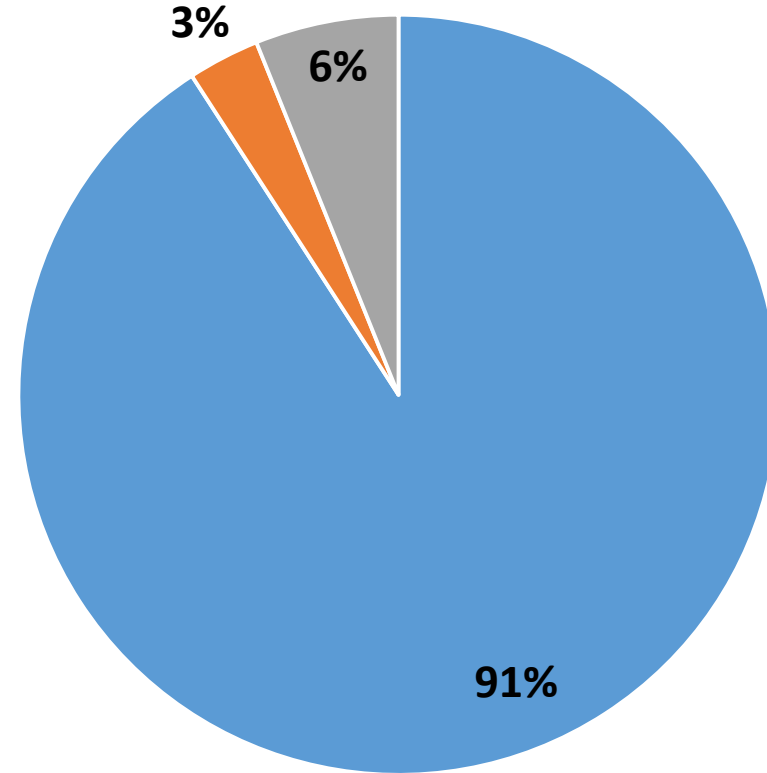

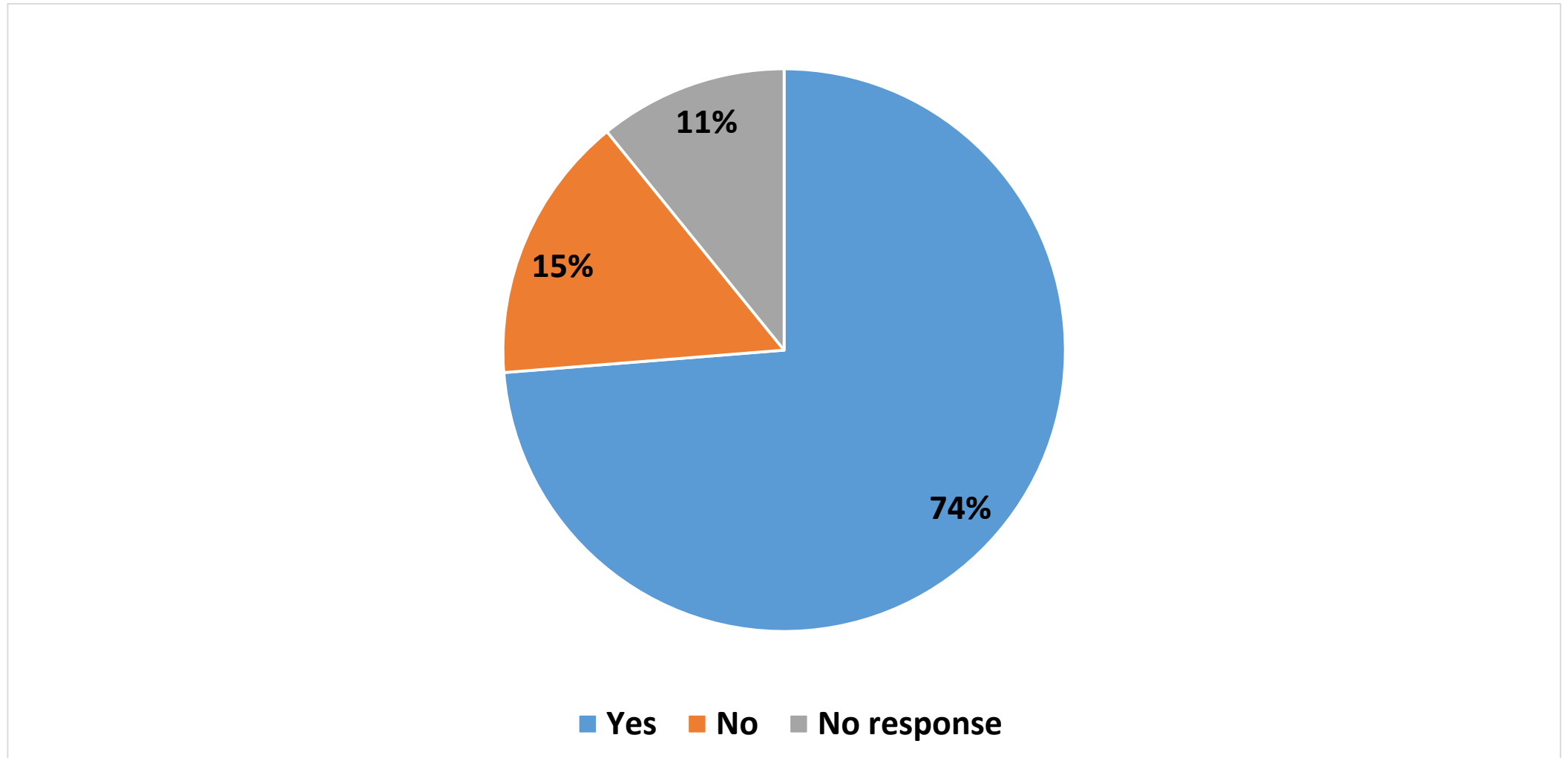

Do you support the protection and development of local retail businesses?

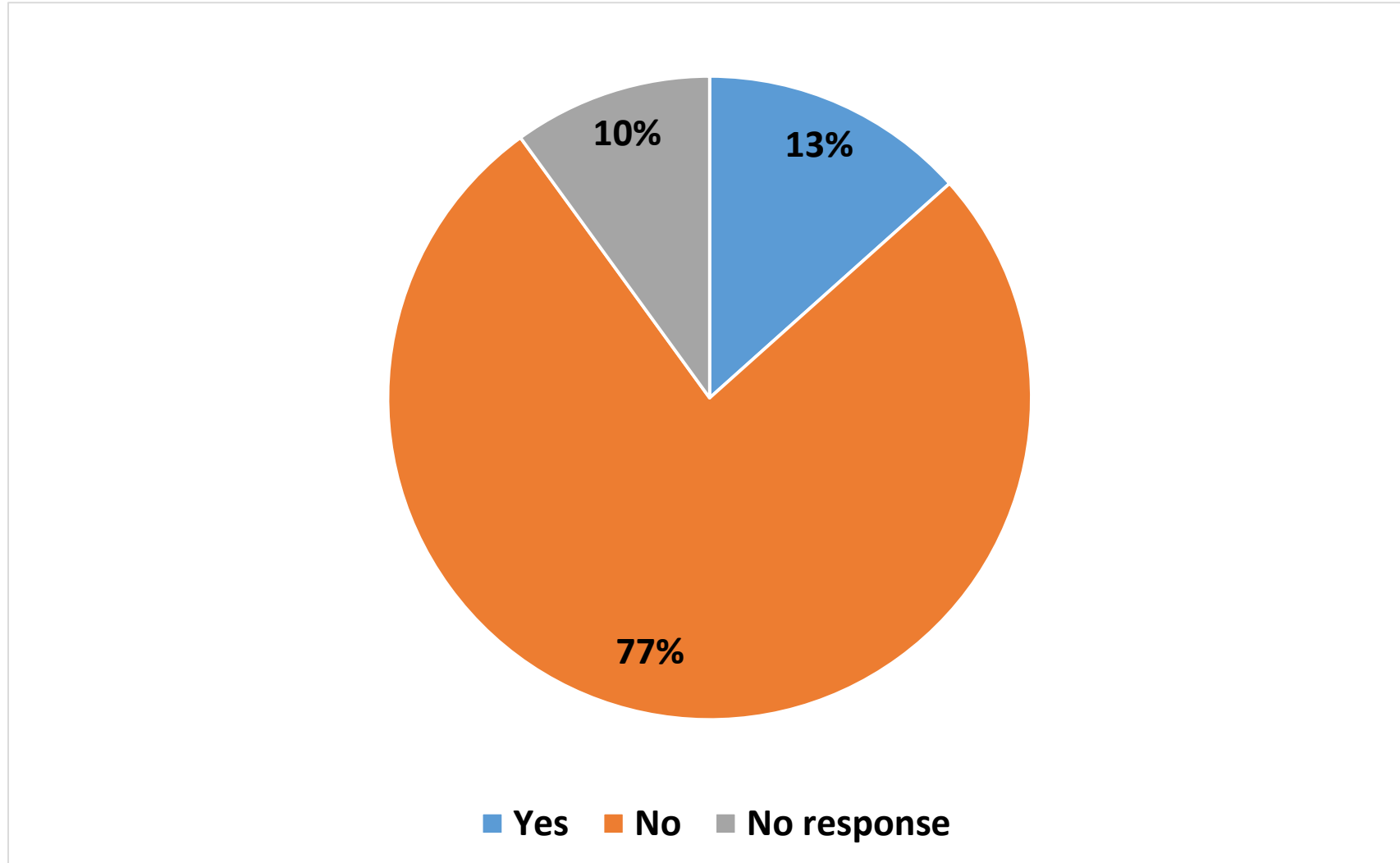
