- 2223/CL/006 To consider proposals from Grow Chiswell Green for a Community Garden Project

Christy Mitchell spoke about Grow Chiswell Green, set up as a not for profit Ltd Company with a plan to register for charitable status. Ideally the group would be looking for a 40mx40m site to establish a Community Garden. A Core of 4 or 5 company directors would be responsible but volunteers could get involved in the establishment and maintenance. Grow Chiswell Green felt that North Close would be ideal. Committee were in principle in support

of proposals. The Council have included the intension to have a community garden in the draft brief for an options study which will then be consulted upon.

Resolved: Cllr Pryce proposed, Cllr Hilton seconded, unanimous, that the Committee offer their 'in principle' support to the concept of a Community Garden being established in Greenwood Park or North Close.

2223/CL/007 To consider proposals from Midway Surgery for collaborative well-being projects

Midway surgery shared plans to expand their services and increase their building in order to bring in clinicians, wellbeing services, social prescribers, including plans to extend into the Parish land to replace parking lost through the extension of the building. Statement from Midway Surgery was read out. The Surgery and keen to work together with residents groups, the parish and users on well being projects in the local area eg park run.

a) Woodbury Field improvements project

Vehicle Crossover permission has been provided by HCC and we are commissioning a company to put in the crossover and an agreement will need to be drawn up for access across the Common.

b) Fixed Assets Strategy

Fixed Assets Committee are meeting on Tuesday to finalise the brief to run a tender for a consultant to undertake an options study for Greenwood Park improvements.

c) Parish Survey

When the option study on Greenwood Park is produced this will be combined with Parish Survey questions already produced to create a wider parish survey and this will be consulted upon in the Autumn

- d) Community orchard or tree planting with St Stephen Gardening Club Cllr Pryce and the Garden Club are meeting at the end of month to discuss where tree planting could go.
