#### 1. Purpose

To discuss and consider installing a lightning protection system (LPS) at Greenwood Park Community Centre.

#### 2. Introduction

St Stephen Parish Council resolved to install solar panels on Greenwood Park Community Centre (Fixed Assets 2 January 2024 item 2324/AC/053). The Chair asked staff to look at the cost of installing lightning protection at the same time and share access to the roof.

#### 3. Next Steps

Installing solar panels does not increase the likelihood of lightning strikes, however installing a LPS as a safety and protection measure should be considered. These systems are designed to safely conduct the electrical current from a lightning strike to the ground, minimizing the potential damage to the solar panels and other electrical components.

- 1) Response from Solar Voltaics Ltd -see email below.
- 2) We obtained two quotes to install lightning protection using shared access:

a) External System	£4,131.00
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b) I	External system	£7,485.00
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**Note:** Type 1 and type 2 surge protection is included in the Solar Voltaic proposal.

#### **RECOMMENDED** that the Committee:

Bearing in mind the solar installation is a priority, to consider installing a LPS at the same time as the solar installation if it can be arranged and if it is cost effective to do so, otherwise to consider installing an LPS afterwards.

Good morning Sue,

I have attached the quotation for LPS. There is quite a lot of additional preparation/groundwork they require before installing which they have not priced for. This would require quotations from a 3<sup>rd</sup> contractor.

On our last project with Portsmouth City Council, the issue of LPS was raised for the buildings they wanted us to install upon and their building team shared a document they had regarding confirmation that solar panels do not increase the risk of lightning strikes to buildings which, if they are happy, I will send to you. This may take a few days to receive, they may not want to share it.

With the timescale for installing the PV in mind, the addition of LPS may be a project you would rather consider after the installation. We have already costed for Type 1 and Type 2 surge protection on the PV system as part of our proposal.

I will leave this with you to discuss and consider.

#### 2. Introduction

The Council resolved in January to request S106 Green Infrastructure funds to install solar panels at Greenwood Park Community Centre. The total remaining fund is £59,900.64.

#### 3. Proposals

- Solar lights along Greenwood Park driveway and solar lighting or bollards the pathway to the park entrance. See quotes below
- Solar lights along Park Street Rec pathway. See quotes below
- Woodland management: to transplant trees from Watling Chase to John Bell's Copse. See plan and quote below
- Bench/benches in St Julian's Wood
- Bluebell Plan: As erosion of the paths is considerable and has led to widening of the pathways and harm to the bluebell, we would like to consider using a post and rope system and rerouting sections of the footpath during the wetter months. See approx. costing below.

#### 4. Financial and Legal Comments

Quote 1 Solar lights will incur an ongoing annual maintenance charge of approx. £1700 after the first year.
